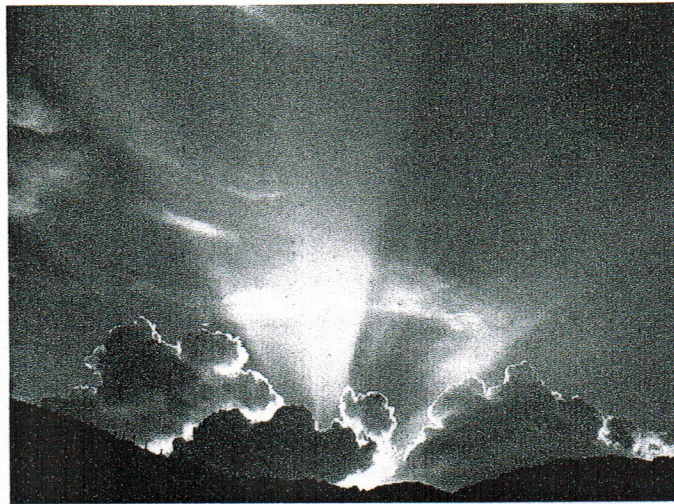


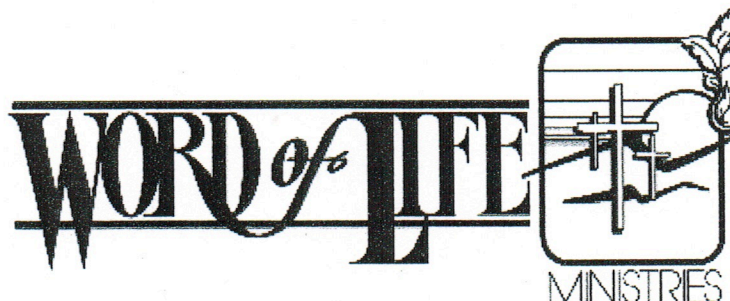

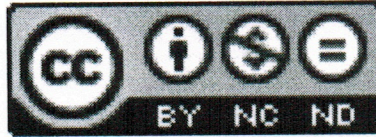

Much can be learned of the Father by simply knowing the meanings of His names, for in His names you will find descriptions of His character, attributes, and the manner in which He wishes to relate to His people.

Below is a listing of the various names applied to God. (Esp. the Father.) Every Christian would do well to memorize these. It helps us to more effectively pray Mt. 6:9: "Our Father which art in Heaven, Hallowed be thy name." Know who God the Father is, who you're praying to, and the various names you can use to specifically address the attributes of the Father when you go to Him with your particular needs, requests, worship, and praise.

The Basic Names of God. (These can all be found with a good Exhaustive Concordance)

Below you will find a listing of scriptures that use the word "God". (KJV) I have chosen the ones that I feel are referring primarily to the Father. (Eventhough the name God is used in the text) These scriptures were selected to describe the Father on the basis of (1) Context, and (2) Other supporting scriptures. When you read these verses from the King James Version (KJV), they will read "God". However, for the brief descriptions listed behind each verse, I will substitute "Father" for the meaning of God.

A. The Father is the Highest Authority.

Luke 1:32 - The Father gave Jesus the Throne.

Acts 2:23 - Through His fore-knowledge, The Father sets what He wants to take place.

Romans 13:1-6 - God has established and controls all authorities/rulers/governments.

" 14:12 - All of us are accountable to and will give account to Him

I Cor. 3:23 - We are of Christ, and Christ is of the Father. (11:3)

I Cor. 6:19 - Believers are owned by The Father.

" 11:22 - The Church is the Father's. (II Cor. 1:1)

" 12:4-6 - The Father is over all gifts/manifestations/ministry.

" 12:18-28 - He has arranged and put the church together the way He wants it.

" 15:28 - Jesus will subject Himself to the Father.

Gal. 4:4 - The Father sent Jesus.

Eph. 1:17 - The Father is over Jesus.

B. Life comes from the Father.

Matt. 4:4 - We live by every word that proceeds from the Father. (Lu. 4:4)

" 22:32 - He is the Father of the living, not the Dead. (Mk. 12:27)

Acts 17:24 - He made the world and everything in it.

" 17:25 - He gives ALL men their Life, Breath, and Everything Else.

" 17:26 - He made every nation from one man.

- He determines our durations of time and where we should live.

" 17:27 - He did this so men would hopefully seek Him.

" 17:28 - In Him, we live, move, and have our being.

Romans 6:23 - Eternal Life comes from the Father.

" 11:36 - He is the Source, Sustainer, and end purpose of all life.

II Cor. 3:5 - Our Adequacy and Competence come from Him.

Col. 3:3 - Our life is hid with Christ in the Father.

I Pet. 4:11 - He provides men with strength and ability.

II Pet. 1:3 - He gave us the new birth.

" 1:4 - He gave us our inheritance.

" 1:5 - His power protects/shields us.

C. The Father Receives Praise and Worship.

Matt. 4:10 - He is to be worshipped. (Lu. 2:13, 4:8)

Rev. 4:8,11 - The Father being Praised/Worshipped. (7:11-12, 11:16-17)

D. Things that Please the Father.

Matt. 15:4 - He's pleased when we honor or parents.

Rom. 14:17-18 - His Kingdom doesn't center on the physical, but on
Righteousness, Joy, and Peace -- These Please the Father.

I Cor. 1:21 - He is pleased by the foolishness of preaching. (1:27-30)

Eph. 1:9 - The revelation of the "Mystery" to humans, pleases Him.

Phil. 4:18 - The Father is pleased with Giving.

I Tim. 2:1,3- When requests/prayers/intercession/thanksgiving are made
for everyone, this Pleases the Father.

" 2:2,3- Esp. when they are made for Kings and those in authority
for the purpose of living peaceful and quiet lives in all
godliness and holiness.

" 5:4 - Caring for our parents/grand-parents pleases the Father.

Heb. 11:6 - Without Faith, it's impossible to please the Father.

" 13:15-16 - He is pleased with sacrifices of praise, doing good,
and sharing with others.

I Pet. 2:20 - He is pleased if we suffer for doing good and endure it.

E. The Father's Will.

Mark 3:35 - Whoever does God's will is Christ's Relative.

Romans 12:2 - The Father looks at things being in His acceptable, good,
or perfect will.

I Thes. 4:3-5 - The Father's will for us is to be holy and avoid sexual
immorality.

- I Thes. 5:18 - His will is for us to be joyful, pray continually, and give thanks in all circumstances.
- I Tim. 2:4 - He wants all people to be saved and come to a knowledge of the Truth.
- I Pet. 2:15 - The Father's will is for us to do good, and by it silence the mouths of ignorant men.
- " 4:19 - If we suffer for the Father's will, we should commit ourselves to Him and continue doing good.

F. The Father is the God of/God who has:

- Luke 1:78 - Tender Mercy.
" 2:40 - Grace. (The Introductions to Paul's epistles)
" 3:6 - Salvation.
- Romans 2:4 - Kindness/Goodness that leads to salvation.
" 3:25 - Forbearance
" 5:2 - Glory.
" 7:22 - Law & Order. (7:25)
" 8:17 - Heirs. (Gal. 4:7)
" 8:19 - Sons. (Gal. 4:7)
" 9:16 - Mercy & Compassion.
" 11:22 - Sternness and kindness toward man.
" 15:13 - Hope. (A very positive God.)
" 15:33 - Peace. (16:20, I Cor. 14:33, Phil. 4:7,9)
- I Cor. 14:33 - Peace; Not confusion and disorder.
- II Cor. 1:3-4 - Comfort; who comforts us. (7:6)
- II Tim. 1:7 - Power, Love, & Sound Mind/Self-Discipline --- Not Fear and Timidity.

G. He is the Father of Salvation.

- Luke 3:6 - Salvation comes from Him.
- John 1:12-13 - The Authority for salvation comes from the Father.
" 1:12 - He also gives us the power to become His children. (Rom. 8:21, Gal. 3:26)
" 3:16 - He loves the world and wants it saved, Not Condemned.
" 6:45 - He teaches ALL Men, and they that listen come to Him.
- Acts 2:39 - The Father calls men to salvation.
" 17:30 - He wants all men to repent.
- Romans 11:32 - The Father calls ALL men sinners, so He can have mercy on ALL of them.

- II Cor. 4:6 - The Father made spiritual light to shine in us via Christ.
" 5:18-19 - He reconciled us to Himself through Jesus.
" 5:21 - Through what He did in Jesus, we can become God's righteousness. (Phil. 3:9)
" 9:8 - It's the Father who makes all grace abound to us and takes care of us.
- Eph. 2:8 - Salvation is a Gift from the Father.
" 2:10 - He prepared in advance for us to do good works.
- I Thes. 5:9 - He has not appointed us to wrath, but to receive salvation
II Thes. 2:13 - The Father chose men to be saved.
- I Tim. 2:4 - He wants all people to be saved.
- Heb. 2:4 - He testified to salvation by signs, wonders, miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- Rev. 5:9-10 - The Father sees believers being bought by Jesus for Him, so we could serve Him. (7:15)

H. The Father and Work.

- Luke 7:16-30 - The Father works through people.
- John 5:17 - The Son saw the Father at work. (5:19)
" 6:29 - The Work of God is to Believe in Jesus.
- Acts 19:11 - He does special miracles through men.
- I Cor. 3:9 - We work together with God as He builds and makes us.
" 4:20 - The Father is not just talk, but POWER.
- Eph. 2:10 - He prepared in advance for us to do good works.
- Heb. 4:4,9 - Since the Father rested from His work, He wants us to rest from ours.

I. The Father's Love.

- John 3:16 - He Loves the world and wants us saved, not condemned.
- Romans 5:5,8 - He loved us so much that while we were sinners, He gave Jesus to die for us. And now He makes His love real to us by His Holy Spirit.
- II Cor. 9:7 - He Loves Cheerful Givers.
- Col. 3:12 - He chooses and dearly Loves Believers. (I Thes. 1:4)

- Heb. 11:16 - The Father is not ashamed of people who long after Him and strive to serve Him -- No matter what the circumstances may look like.
- " 12:7 - He Loves us enough to discipline us.
- I John 4:16 - He Loves us.

J. The Wrath/Judgment of the Father.

- John 3:36 - The Wrath of the Father is on Unbelievers.
- Romans 1:32 - He works with judgment. (2:2-3,5)
- " 12:17-21 - His wrath will vindicate His people.
- Eph. 5:6 - He has wrath.
- Col. 3:5-6 - The Father's wrath is coming because of immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and greed.
- Heb. 10:26-31 - If we deliberately keep on living in sin, we will be judged by the Father (?) - Jesus. This will be Dreadful.
- II Pet. 2:4-9 - He knows how to rescue believers from trials, as well as, hold the unrighteous for judgment.
- Rev. 14:10 - He has wrath. (10:19, 15:1, 19:15)

K. The Father gives Honor/Praise/Commendation.

- John 12:43 - He praises/commends those who live for Him. (Rom. 2:29, I Cor. 4:5)
- Acts 5:31 - He exalted Jesus.
- I Peter 5:6 - Humble yourself before Him, and He'll lift you up.

L. The Father and Gifts.

- Acts 5:32 - The Holy Spirit is given as a gift to those who obey the Father.
- " 8:20 - The Holy Spirit is a gift from the Father. (11:17)
- Romans 5:15 - The Father's Grace and the gift of the Holy Spirit come by Jesus.
- " 6:23 - Eternal life is a gift of the Father.
- " 11:29 - He does not take back a gift or a call.

" 6:9-10 - The Father doesn't give His best to immoral people, idolaters, adulterers, prostitutes, homosexuals, thieves, greedy people, drunks, slanderers, swindlers.
" 12:4-6 - The gifts of the Spirit and their working with men, originate with the Father.
" 15:57 - The Father gives us victory through Jesus. (II Cor. 2:14)
- Eph. 3:7 - Our callings are gifts that originate with the Father.
- Hebrews 2:4 - The gifts of the Spirit are distributed according to the Father's will.
- James 1:5 - The Father gives wisdom to all who ask.
- II Pet. 1:3 - He has given us everything we need for life and godliness.

M. The Father and Covenant.

- Acts 3:25 - Abraham's covenant was between man and the Father.
- Hebrews 6:17 - The Father wants to make the unchanging nature of His promise very plain to all the heirs. That promise being we are part of Abraham's covenant.
" 8:8-12 - The Father made the NEW COVENANT. (10:12-17)
- James 4:4 - To be "Friends" (In Covenant) with the world is to be in hatred toward/an enemy of the Father.
- Rev. 21:7 - Overcoming places us in Covenant in His sight.

N. The Sovereignty of the Father.

- Acts 22:14 - He chose Paul to know His will, see Jesus, Hear His words.
- Romans 9:16 - By His mercy He chooses what is best for us - either mercy, or compassion.
" 11:33-36 - God's wisdom, knowledge, judgment, and ways are beyond man. No man fully knows God's mind, or can give Him counsel. God doesn't owe man anything.
- I Cor. 7:17 - The Father assigns and calls each person to a specific place in life. (II Cor. 10:13, Gal. 1:15, Phil.3:14-15)
" 15:38 - The Father has chosen what types of bodies the various life forms have.
- Hebrews 6:3 - We can only do what the Father permits.
- Rev. 17:17 - The Father uses people (Saved or Unsaved) to accomplish His purpose. (Rom. 9:17)
