An Update about Fall Extravaganza

King Road has a long tradition of offering a positive, family-oriented event on October 31st. We call this event Fall Extravaganza. Many memories and positive experiences have taken place in our church gym over the years.

As the pastoral team, we sat down and discussed our plans for Fall Extravaganza. We asked the “why/purpose” questions. We discussed the details. We reflected on trends and observations about who was attending, who was involved, and if it was helping us fulfill our mandate as a congregation. Out of this conversation came the idea to make some changes for this year’s event. We desire to impact the communities where we as King Roaders live.

Fall Extravaganza - Neighbourhood Edition

We want to encourage and equip the congregation to take the opportunity to bless their neighbourhoods (rather than abandoning our neighbourhoods on a night when many voluntarily come and visit our homes).

Here are some ideas:

- Set up on your driveway, light your propane fire, put out the lawn chairs, serve coffee, play worship music, have lawn games for the kids to play.
- Warmly greet all those who stop by, learn names, engage with the parents and children
- Share an invitation (whether to coffee, a neighbourhood dinner, or to church).

We are working on providing some basic information to handout (if you choose too). This will be available on October 28th.

Staying in our church gym would be more comfortable (and maybe drier too!), but we feel this is an opportunity to step out of our comfort zone. Do we know our neighbours? Are we taking the opportunities to interact, to build relationship? This is our challenge!

We are anticipating the stories that you will share with the rest of the congregation. Sharing our experiences helps us spur each other on to love and good deeds. Use the hashtag **#kingroadloves** on social media. Sharing our stories will also help us plan for future years.

Stay tuned...next week we plan on sharing some ideas that people are planning for this event.

Some Questions and Answers You May Have

What is the church providing for participants?

We will provide you with a small handout directing people to our church website. We are also gathering other good material which you might wish to share with some of your guests. We will share ideas with each other. We will encourage each other. We will not buy candy for you, but we do have some funds to assist you implementing your ideas. Please contact the office.

No one ever comes to my door. What should I do?

We would encourage you to get together with someone else (whether from King Road or someone in your neighbourhood) and help them “host” at their place. Serving together is very encouraging, and helps us to be bold in our witness.

I always invite my friends to come to King Road for Fall Extravaganza. Now what?

Invite them to stop by your place. Invite them to assist you in hosting. Prepare a positive environment. If games are key, set up a hockey net and offer prizes for anyone who can score. Be creative. Continue to build relationships.

I'll really miss the dunk tank.

Do you mean you'll miss throwing balls and dunking someone, or miss being dunked? Some of us won't miss it nearly so much :) Rumour has it, however, that it will be used somewhere in our community on October 31st.

What about hot dogs, chips, and drinks?

If you have a BBQ, why not fire it up and give away hot dogs for a donation? Though, imagine what might happen if you barbeque steak and ribs for the neighbourhood?

I like the concept, but I'm a little scared of trying something new. Can you help?

Yes. We will encourage and pray. It's okay to be scared. We would love to see groups of people (for example, care groups, youth, small groups) serve together. Don't feel you have to do this alone.

This sounds like a great challenge for families with older children. But my children are young and I don't want them to see all the costumes, etc.

Please do whatever necessary to take care of your children. We are not saying you need to take them out in your neighbourhood if you don't feel comfortable with that. We would encourage you, however, to turn your outside lights on and bless your neighbours as they come to your home. Let your light shine!
