

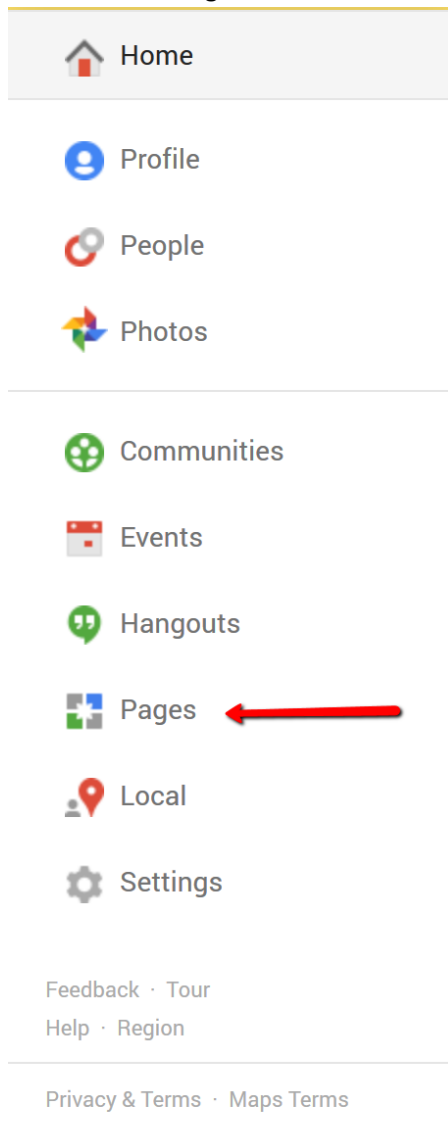
## Google Plus

**Note:** If you have configured your account and it still fails to create a post, go to 'Troubleshooting' section in the bottom of this guide.

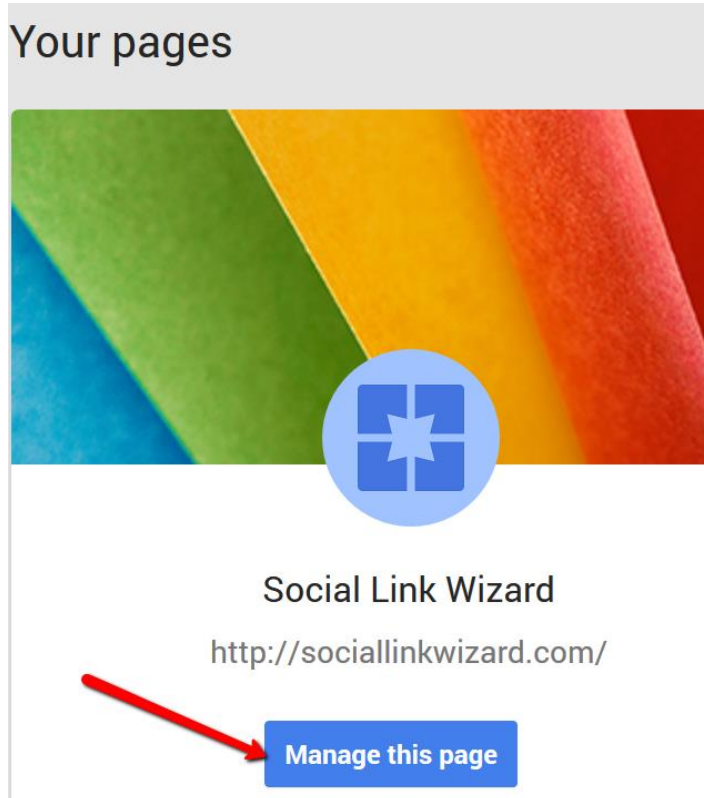
1. If you want to post to a particular Google+ page, than you need to get its Page ID:

a. Login to your account

b. Go to Home->Pages:



- c. Click on 'Manage this page' on a page you are interested in:



- d. Copy your page ID from the address bar in your browser:



Copy just the numbers and nothing else

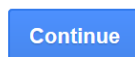
2. Go to <https://www.google.com/accounts/UnlockCaptcha>

Click 'Continue' button:

To allow access, click the Continue button below.





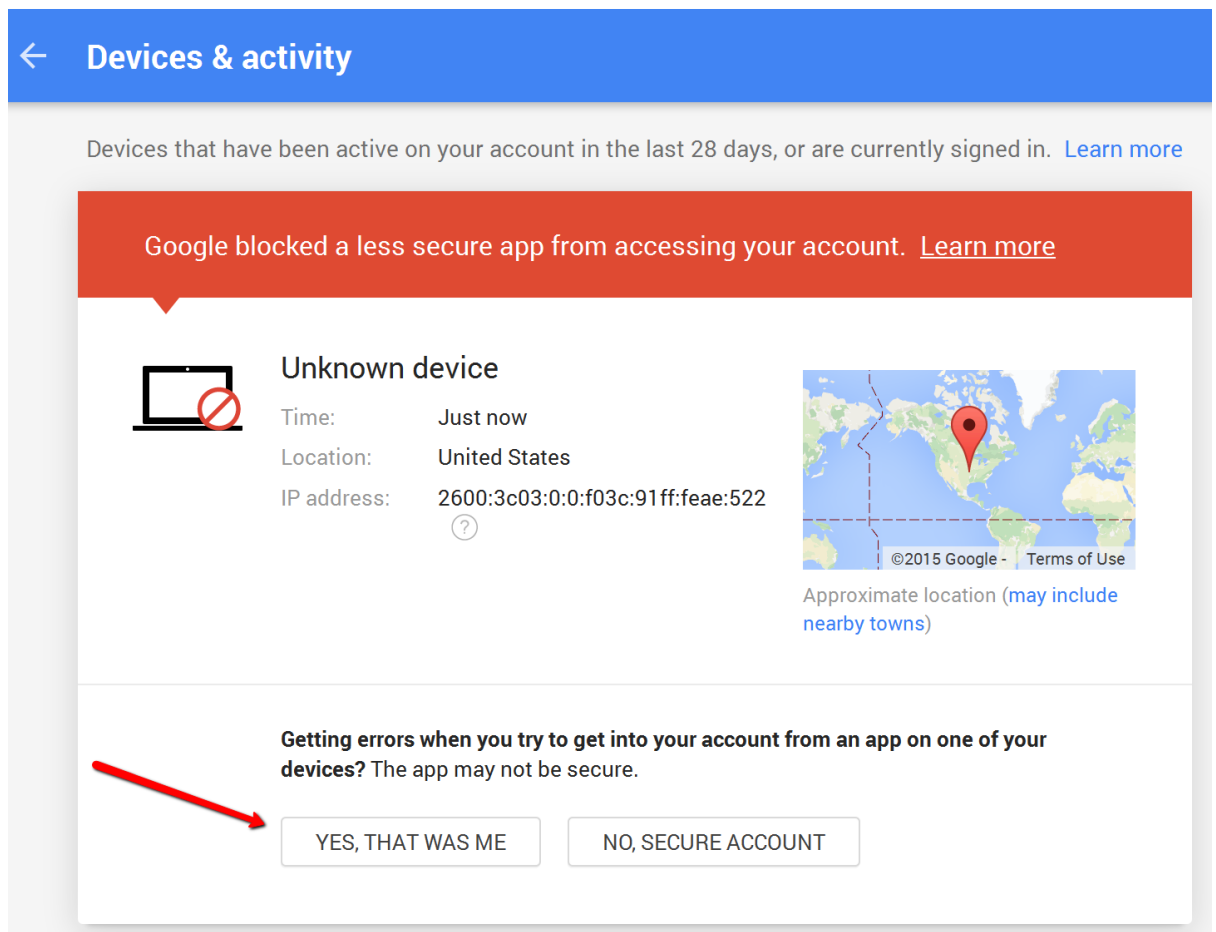

## Troubleshooting

1. Try to create a post via SLM
2. Login to your Google account <https://www.google.com/settings/personalinfo>
3. Go to <https://security.google.com/settings/security/activity> to check your recent activity. Once you are on that page, select sign-ins that were prevented and confirm that they were yours.



Please note that Google UI is a subject to change. The main point is to confirm that it was you who tried to access your account from that IP.

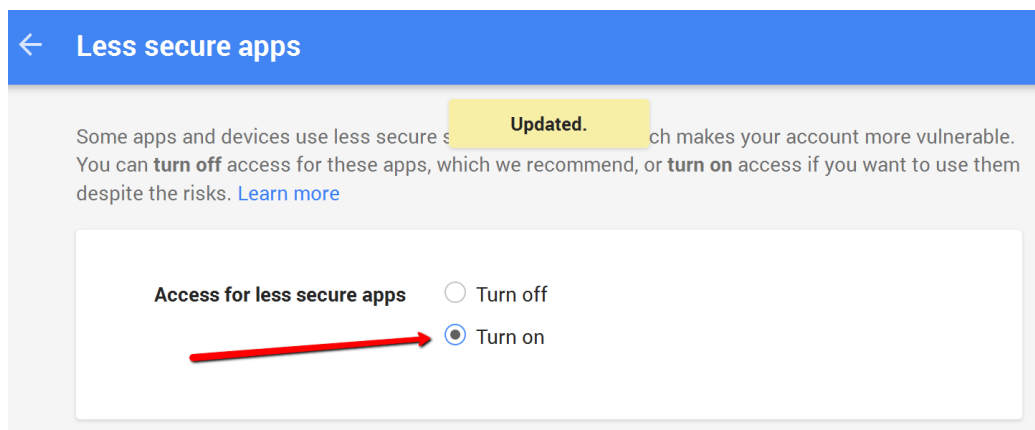
