Voting From Europe

WHEN YOU'RE STUDYING ABROAD

Step 1

Register & request your absentee ballot with the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA)

Step 2

Fill out & send in your ballot when it arrives!

The Full Breakdown:

- 1** Go to: www.fvap.gov > Overseas Citizen Voter > Absentee Voting Overview
- 2** Click on "Voter Registration and Ballots"
- 3** Select your state and primary (or most recent) U.S. address.
- 4** You will be provided your state's specific voting information, including deadlines. Review the requirements. Select an option with which to fill out the FPCA (bottom left). *Tip: The FVAP's Online Assistant is often the easiest.
- 5** Download, print and sign the form. You must sign by hand, even if the rest of the form was filled out electronically, or it won't be accepted.
- 6** Scan the completed form into your computer to send via email to your election official. You may also send via postal mail or fax (Your state might require one of these options).
- 7** Your Absentee Ballot will arrive via on the method you select in your application. Complete ballot and return via mail, email, or fax before the deadline.
