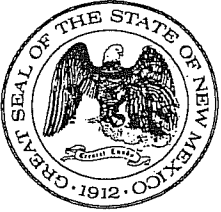

The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.


