CONTRACT TITLE: POLICE RADAR, LIDAR, PARTS AND ACCESSORIES

CONTRACT PERIOD: OCTOBER 31, 2011 THROUGH OCTOBER 30, 2013

Contract C114080003 is awarded by the State of Missouri consisting of the following:

- ❖ The attached Contract #01611, signed by the State of Washington, Washington State Department of Enterprise Services 10/20/11.
- ❖ The Participating Addendum Master Agreement.

The contractor shall provide police radar, lidar, parts and accessories to the State of Missouri, political subdivision or governmental entities specified by the State of Missouri at the firm, fixed prices specified in the State of Washington Contract C01611. All references to the State of Washington, in the attached documentation shall be deemed to refer to the State of Missouri with the exception of information specific to the State of Washington such as background information, statistical/factual information, etc.

Federal Funds Requirement:

The contractor shall understand and agree that this procurement may involve the expenditure of federal funds. Therefore, in accordance with the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, Public Law 101-166, Section 511, "Steven's Amendment", the contractor shall not issue any statements, press releases, and other documents describing projects or programs funded in whole or in part with Federal funds unless the prior approval of the state agency is obtained and unless they clearly state the following as provided by the state agency:

- The percentage of the total costs of the program or project which will be financed with Federal funds;
- The dollar amount of Federal funds for the project or program; and
- Percentage and dollar amount of the total costs of the project or program that will be financed by nongovernmental sources.

Contractor's Personnel:

The contractor shall only employ personnel authorized to work in the United States in accordance with applicable federal and state laws. This includes but is not limited to the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act (IIRIRA) and INA Section 274A.

If the contractor is found to be in violation of this requirement or the applicable state, federal and local laws and regulations, and if the State of Missouri has reasonable cause to believe that the contractor has knowingly employed individuals who are not eligible to work in the United States, the state shall have the right to cancel the contract immediately without penalty or recourse and suspend or debar the contractor from doing business with the state.

The contractor shall agree to fully cooperate with any audit or investigation from federal, state, or local law enforcement agencies.

Cooperative Procurement Program:

The contractor shall provide police radar, lidar, parts and accessories as described herein under the terms and conditions, requirements and specifications of the contract, including prices, to other government entities in accordance with the Technical Services Act (67.360 RSMo, which is available on the internet at: <http://www.moga.mo.gov/statutes/c000-099/0670000360.htm>.) The contractor shall further understand and agree that participation by other governmental entities is discretionary on the part of that governmental entity and the State of Missouri bears no financial responsibility for any payments due the contractor by such governmental entities.

Instructions for Certification

1. By signing and submitting this proposal, the prospective recipient of Federal assistance funds is providing the certification as set out below.
2. The certification in this clause is a material representation of fact upon which reliance was placed when this transaction was entered into. If it is later determined that the prospective recipient of Federal assistance funds knowingly rendered an erroneous certification, in addition to other remedies available to the Federal Government, the Department of Labor (DOL) may pursue available remedies, including suspension and/or debarment.
3. The prospective recipient of Federal assistance funds shall provide immediate written notice to the person to which this proposal is submitted if at any time the prospective recipient of Federal assistance funds learns that its certification was erroneous when submitted or has become erroneous by reason of changed circumstances.
4. The terms "covered transaction," "debarred," "suspended," "ineligible," "lower tier covered transaction," "participant," "person," "primary covered transaction," "principal," "proposal," and "voluntarily excluded," as used in this clause, have the meanings set out in the Definitions and Coverage sections of rules implementing Executive Order 12549. You may contact the person to which this proposal is submitted for assistance in obtaining a copy of those regulations.
5. The prospective recipient of Federal assistance funds agrees by submitting this proposal that, should the proposed covered transaction be entered into, it shall not knowingly enter into any lower tier covered transaction with a person who is debarred, suspended, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this covered transaction, unless authorized by the DOL.
6. 1. Scope:

This addendum covers the WSCA Police Radar, Lidar, Parts and Accessories contract lead by the State of Washington for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State authorized by that state's statutes to utilize state contracts.

2. Participation:

Use of specific WSCA/NASPO cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases products/services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. Except to the extent modified by a Participating Addendum, each agency and political subdivision will be responsible to follow the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement; and they will have the same rights and responsibilities for their purchases as the Lead State has in the Master Agreement. Each agency and political subdivision will be responsible for their own charges, fees, and liabilities. Each agency and political subdivision will have the same rights to any indemnity or to recover any costs allowed in the contract for their purchases. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

This Participating Addendum and the WSCA Master Agreement together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof. Terms and conditions inconsistent with, contrary or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Participating Addendum and the WSCA Master Agreement, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Participating Addendum or the WSCA Master Agreement and its exhibits, by any subsequent Purchase Order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Participating Addendum and the WSCA Master Agreement and its exhibits shall

prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms.



