- 2. <u>Participation:</u> Use of specific **WSCA** cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use **state/entity** contracts are subject to the approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

INDIVIDUAL CUSTOMER: Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases products/services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. Except to the extent modified by this Participating Addendum, each agency and political subdivision will be responsible to follow the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement; and they will have the same rights and responsibilities for their purchases as the Lead State has in the Master Agreement. Each agency and political subdivision will be responsible for their own charges, fees, and liabilities. Each agency and political subdivision will have the same rights to any indemnity or to recover any costs allowed in the contract for their purchases. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

- 3. <u>Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Price Agreement:</u>
 (These modifications or additions apply only to actions and relationships within the Participating Entity.)
 - 1. Authorized Participating Entities. Participant hereby authorizes the following entities as "Participating Entities" under the Agreement: Entities authorized too participate in cooperative purchasing with the State under North Dakota Century Code 54-44.4-13, including institutions under the jurisdiction of State Board of Higher Education, K-12 schools, and local government entities. For purposed of this authorization the term "Government entities: means counties, cities, townships, institutions under the jurisdiction of State Board or Higher Education, public primary and secondary educational entities, governmental boards and commissions, and nonprofit entities established on behalf of public entities for the purpose of purchasing.

2. Termination of Contract.

a. Termination without cause. This contract may be terminated by mutual consent of both parties.

- b. Termination for lack of funding or authority. STATE by written notice of default to CONTRACTOR, may terminate the whole or any part of this contract, under any of the following conditions:
 - (1) If funding from federal, state, or other sources is not obtained and continued at levels sufficient to allow for purchase of the services or supplies in the indicated quantities or term.
 - (2) If federal or state laws or rules are modified or interpreted in a way that the services are no longer allowable or appropriate for purchase under this contract or are no longer eligible for the funding proposed for payments authorized by this contract.
 - (3) If any license, permit, or certificate required by law or rule, or by the terms of this contract, is for any reason denied, revoked, suspended, or not renewed.

Termination of this contract under this subsection is without prejudice to any obligations or liabilities of either party already accrued prior to termination.

- c. Termination for cause. STATE may terminate this contract effective upon delivery of written notice to CONTRACTOR, or any later date stated in the notice:
 - (1) If CONTRACTOR fails to provide services required by this contract within the time specified or any extension agreed to by STATE; or
 - (2) If CONTRACTOR fails to perform any of the other provisions of this contract, or so fails to pursue the work as to endanger performance of this contract in accordance with its terms.

The rights and remedies of STATE provided in this subsection are not exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or under this contract.

- 3. Continuation of Participation. The term of this Participating Addendum must be coterminous with the WSCA Master Agreement, #1907, to include all contract extensions and renewals.
- 4. Reports. The contractor must maintain records of sales under this Participating Addendum and furnish volume of sales information to the Purchasing Agency or Entity/State within 15 business day upon written request of the Purchasing Agency or Entity/State. Reports will include agency name, invoice date, invoice amount, and summary of items purchased.

- 5. Merger and Modification. This Participating Addendum and TESSCO Master Service Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. There are no understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified within this contract. This contract may not be modified, supplemented or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by both parties.
- 6. Notices. All notices or other communications required under this contract must be given by registered or certified mail and are complete on the date mailed when addressed to the Primary Contacts listed below. Notice provided under this provision does not meet the notice requirements for monetary claims against the State found at N.D.C.C. § 32-12.2-04.
- 7. Applicable Law and Venue. This contract is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of North Dakota. Any action to enforce this contract must be adjudicated exclusively in the State District Court of Burleigh County, North Dakota.
- 8. Spoliation Notice of Potential Claims. CONTRACTOR shall promptly notify STATE of all potential claims that arise or result from this contract. CONTRACTOR shall also take all reasonable steps to preserve all physical evidence and information that may be relevant to the circumstances surrounding a potential claim, while maintaining public safety, and grants to STATE the opportunity to review and inspect the evidence, including the scene of an accident.
- 9. Indemnification. To the extent of Contractor's negligence. Contractor agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the state of North Dakota, its agencies, officers and employees (State), from and against claims based on the vicarious liability of the State or its agents, but not against claims based on the State's contributory negligence, comparative and/or contributory negligence or fault, sole negligence, or intentional misconduct. The legal defense provided by Contractor to the State under this provision must be free of any conflicts of interest, even if retention of separate legal counsel for the State is necessary. Contractor also agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the State harmless for all costs, expenses and attorneys' fees incurred if the State prevails in an action against Contractor in establishing and litigating the indemnification coverage provided herein. This obligation shall continue after the termination of this agreement.
- **10. Insurance.** The insurance coverages listed in the Master Service Agreement must also meet the following additional requirements:
 - a. Employer's liability or "stop gap" insurance of not less than \$1,000,000 as an endorsement on the workers compensation or commercial general liability insurance.
 - a provision that any attorney who represents the State under this policy must first qualify as and be appointed by the North Dakota Attorney General as a Special Assistant Attorney General as required under N.D.C.C. § 54-12-08;

- d. The legal defense provided to the State under the policy and any endorsements must be free of any conflicts of interest, even if retention of separate legal counsel for the State is necessary;

- 12. Alternative Dispute Resolution Jury Trial. STATE does not agree to any form of binding arbitration, mediation, or other forms of mandatory alternative dispute resolution. The parties have the right to enforce their rights and remedies in judicial proceedings. STATE does not waive any right to a jury trial.
- 13. Confidentiality. CONTRACTOR shall not use or disclose any information it receives from STATE under this contract that STATE has previously identified as confidential or exempt from mandatory public disclosure except as necessary to carry out the purposes of this contract or as authorized in advance by STATE. STATE shall not disclose any information it receives from CONTRACTOR that CONTRACTOR has previously identified as confidential and that STATE determines in its sole discretion is protected from mandatory public disclosure under a specific exception to the North Dakota open records law, N.D.C.C. chapter 44-04. The duty of STATE and CONTRACTOR to maintain confidentiality of information under this section continues beyond the term of this contract.
- 14. Compliance with Public Records Law. CONTRACTOR understands that, except for disclosures prohibited in this contract, STATE must disclose to the public upon request any records it receives from CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR further understands that any records that are obtained or generated by CONTRACTOR under this contract, except for records that are confidential under this contract, may, under certain circumstances, be open to the public upon request under the North Dakota open records law. CONTRACTOR agrees to contact STATE immediately upon receiving a request for information under the open records law and to comply with STATE'S instructions on how to respond to the request.
