1. Scope: This addendum allows for purchase of the following Computer Equipment/Services: Band 1 - Desktop, Band 2 - Laptop and Band 3 - Tablet led by the State of Minnesota along with a multi-state sourcing team for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State/Entity that is authorized by that state's statutes to utilize state /entity contracts, and which receives prior written approval of the state's chief procurement official.

The original solicitation contains the requirements and definitions establishing the following Product Bands allowed on the Master Agreement. The Master Agreement identifies the bands awarded to the Contractor. The configuration limits and restrictions for the Master Agreement are provided with revisions identified by the Participating State in this Participating Addendum.

2. Participation: Use of specific NASPO ValuePoint cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use **state** contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective State Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

3. Order of Precedence:

1. A Participating Entity's Participating Addendum ("PA"); A Participating Entity's Participating Addendum shall not diminish, change, or impact the rights of the Lead State with regard to the Lead State's contractual relationship with the Contractor under the Terms of Minnesota NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement
2. Minnesota NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement (includes negotiated Terms & Conditions)
3. The Solicitation including all Addendums; and
4. Contractor's response to the Solicitation

These documents shall be read to be consistent and complementary. Any conflict among these documents shall be resolved by giving priority to these documents in the order listed above. Contractor terms and conditions that apply to this Master Agreement are only those that are expressly accepted by the Lead State and must be in writing and attached to the Master Agreement.

No other terms and conditions shall apply, including terms and conditions listed in the Contractor's response to the Solicitation, or terms listed or referenced on the Contractor's website, or in the Contractor quotation/sales order. The solicitation language prevails unless a mutually agreed exception has been negotiated.

4. Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Agreement:

- a) The laws of the State of Kansas shall govern this agreement.
- b) State of Kansas Contractual Provisions Attachment (as modified), DA-146a attached and incorporated into this Addendum as Attachment A will have prior precedence over the listed items in section.
- c) Travel expenses if applicable, shall be reimbursed under the same rates and conditions as noted in the "Employee Travel Expense Reimbursement Handbook" found at: <http://da.state.ks.us/ar/employee/travel/travbk.htm> unless otherwise agreed upon with the purchasing entity. Such information will be detailed in a Statement of Work signed by the parties.
- d) Upon request of the Purchasing Entity, the Contractor shall accept a Business Procurement Card (BPC) for payment under this agreement if presented at the time of purchase.
- e) Reports and Administrative Fees:  
The Contractor shall submit quarterly reports to the Division of Purchases for all acquisitions, less returned product ("actual, net invoice sales"), made from this Addendum. This report should include the agency name, quantity, description and amount. The report will be provided electronically and a check sent payable to the State of Kansas – Office of Procurement and Contracts for an amount equal to one half of one percent (0.50%) of the total actual sales. The report and fee shall be submitted 30 days following the end of the Contractor Fiscal quarter, as set forth below, to [reports@da.ks.gov](mailto:reports@da.ks.gov).

6. **Partner Utilization:** Each state represented by NASPO ValuePoint participating in this Master Agreement independently have the option of utilizing partners. Only partners approved by this Participating State may be deployed. The participating State will define the process to add and remove partners and may define the partner's role in their participating addendum. The Contractors partners' participation will be in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the aforementioned Master Agreement.

No partners will be utilized by Contractor under this Addendum. Contractor may contract with an Apple Authorized Service provider on its behalf.

7. **Terms.** The Participating State/Entity is agreeing to the terms of the Master Agreement only to the extent the terms are not in conflict with applicable law.

Contractor acknowledges that Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity is a political subdivision of the State of Kansas. Parties agree that this Addendum is subject to

Kansas State laws and any provision of the Addendum that is in direct conflict with applicable Kansas State laws shall be deemed unenforceable.

8. Orders: Any Order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a Product and/or Service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement.

All orders are to reference State Contract #40398 on the Purchase Order. Ordering instructions will be provided on a separate listing and are to be provided to the participating State when changes occur.

9. Leasing. Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity that have the authority may finance their purchases through a lease agreement with Contractor. If financing is through a lease agreement, that agreement is separate from this Addendum and between Contractor and the Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity.

10. Services. The terms of the Master Agreement shall apply each time Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity engages Contractor to provide services. All services provided will be described in one or more of the following documents:

- (i) "Service Descriptions" used to describe any services purchased by an entity;
- (ii) Any mutually agreed upon "Statement of Work" ("SOW") executed by the parties.

11. Delivery. In those situations in which the "deliver-to" address has no receiving dock or agents, the Contractor must be able to deliver to the location specified on the Purchase Order without additional cost. If there is a special case where inside delivery fee must be charged and is clearly specified on Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity's order, the Contractor will notify them in advance in order for the Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity to determine if the additional cost will affect the decision to utilize the Contractor.

12. Insurance. Contractor shall have the option to self-insure, as long as Contractor maintains an audited net worth (Shareholder's Equity) of \$100,000,000.00.

13. Payment. Provided Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity is qualified for credit with Contractor, payment is due no later than 30 days from the invoice date. Payments may be made via a State or political subdivision purchasing card if presented at time of order.

14. Audit. All audit obligations shall only survive for a period of five (5) years from the invoice date of the transaction under this Addendum.
15. Licensing. Contractor's standard licensing terms accompanying any Apple Product shall control the use of the Apple Product.
16. Acceptance Testing. As it applies to Section 28 of the Master Agreement Terms and Conditions, B. WSCA-NASPO Terms and Conditions, Contractor shall make available to the Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity a process by which the Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity can evaluate and test certain Contractor-branded hardware. Any Acceptance Testing of this type shall be pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Contractor Equipment Loan Agreement, which will be provided by the Contractor upon request.

19. Entire Agreement; Modifications. Neither Contractor nor Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity will be liable for any agreements, warranties, understandings, conditions, covenants, or representations not expressly set forth or referenced in this Addendum. Any different or additional provisions in purchase orders, invoices or similar documents issued by Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity at any time are hereby deemed refused by Contractor and such refused provisions will be unenforceable. Except as otherwise provided in this Addendum, no modification to this Addendum will be binding unless in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each party.



CONTRACTUAL PROVISIONS ATTACHMENT

Important: This form contains mandatory contract provisions and must be attached to or incorporated in all copies of any contractual agreement. If it is attached to the Vendor/Contractor's standard contract form, then that form must be altered to contain the following provision:

"The Provisions found in Contractual Provisions Attachment (Form DA-146a, Rev. 06-12), which is attached hereto, are hereby incorporated in this contract and made a part thereof."

The parties agree that the following provisions are hereby incorporated into the contract to which it is attached and made a part thereof.

- 1. Terms Herein Controlling Provisions:** It is expressly agreed that the terms of each and every provision in this attachment shall prevail and control over the terms of any other conflicting provision in any other document relating to and a part of the contract in which this attachment is incorporated. Any terms that conflict or could be interpreted to conflict with this attachment are nullified.
- 2. Kansas Law and Venue:** This contract shall be subject to, governed by, and construed according to the laws of the State of Kansas, and jurisdiction and venue of any suit in connection with this contract shall reside only in courts located in the State of Kansas.
- 3. Termination Due To Lack Of Funding Appropriation:** If, in the judgment of the Director of Accounts and Reports, Department of Administration, sufficient funds are not appropriated to continue the function performed in this agreement and for the payment of the charges hereunder, State may terminate this agreement at the end of its current fiscal year. State agrees to give written notice of termination to Contractor at least 30 days prior to the end of its current fiscal year, and shall give such notice for a greater period prior to the end of such fiscal year as may be provided in this contract, except that such notice shall not be required prior to 90 days before the end of such fiscal year. Contractor shall have the right, at the end of such fiscal year, to take possession of any equipment provided State under the contract. State will pay to the Contractor all regular contractual payments incurred through the end of such fiscal year, plus contractual charges incidental to the return of any such equipment. Upon termination of the agreement by State, title to any such equipment shall revert to Contractor at the end of the State's current fiscal year. The termination of the contract pursuant to this paragraph shall not cause any penalty to be charged to the agency or the Contractor. The Contractor acknowledges that the State cannot contract for the payment of funds not yet appropriated by the Kansas State Legislature. If funding to the State of Kansas is reduced due to a non-appropriation by the Legislature or the Governor, or is required by Kansas State law, or if federal funding (when applicable) is not provided, the State of Kansas may terminate this contract upon 30 days written notice. In the case that funds are not appropriated or are reduced, the State of Kansas will reimburse Contractor for products ordered or services performed through the date of cancellation or reduction.
- 4. Anti-Discrimination Clause:** The Contractor agrees: (a) to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001 et seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111 et seq.) and the applicable provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) (ADA) and to not discriminate against any person because of race, religion, color, sex, disability, national origin or ancestry, or age in the admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs or activities; (b) to include in all solicitations or advertisements for employees, the phrase "equal opportunity employer"; (c) to provide upon request, documentation satisfactory to the Kansas Human Rights Commission of the actions taken to verify Contractor's good faith compliance with the requirements of this anti-discrimination section (d) that a failure to comply with the reporting requirements of (c) above or if the Contractor is found guilty of any violation of such acts by the Kansas Human Rights Commission, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration; (e) if it is determined that the Contractor has violated applicable provisions of ADA, such violation shall constitute a breach of contract and the contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended, in whole or in part, by the contracting state agency or the Kansas Department of Administration.

Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal anti-discrimination laws.

The provisions of this paragraph number 4 (with the exception of those provisions relating to the ADA) are not applicable to a Contractor who employs fewer than four employees during the term of such contract or whose contracts with the contracting State agency cumulatively total \$5,000 or less during the fiscal year of such agency.

- 5. Acceptance Of Contract:** This contract shall not be considered accepted, approved or otherwise effective until the statutorily required approvals and certifications have been given.
- 6. Representative's Authority To Contract:** By signing this contract, the representative of the Contractor thereby represents that such person is duly authorized by the Contractor to execute this contract on behalf of the Contractor and that the Contractor agrees to be bound by the provisions thereof.
- 7. Responsibility For Taxes:** The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be responsible for, nor indemnify a Contractor for, any federal, state or local taxes that may be imposed or levied upon the subject matter of this contract. Notwithstanding the foregoing, should any tax arise from a transaction under this agreement, the Participating Entity shall be responsible for the payment thereof.
- 8. Insurance:** The State of Kansas and its agencies shall not be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to property or any other subject matter relating to this contract, nor shall this contract require them to establish a "self-insurance" fund to protect against any such loss or damage. Subject to the provisions of the Kansas Tort Claims Act (K.S.A. 75-6101 et seq.), the Contractor shall bear the risk of any loss or damage to any property in which the Contractor holds title.
- 9. The Eleventh Amendment:** The Eleventh Amendment is an inherent and incumbent protection with the State of Kansas and need not be reserved, but prudence requires the State to reiterate that nothing related to this contract shall be deemed a waiver of the Eleventh Amendment.
- 10. Campaign Contributions / Lobbying:** Funds provided through a grant award or contract shall not be given or received in exchange for the making of a campaign contribution. No part of the funds provided through this contract shall be used to influence or attempt to influence an officer or employee of any State of Kansas agency or a member of the Legislature regarding any pending legislation or the awarding, extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any government contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement.
