Contractor must submit quarterly reports to the Contracting Officer assigned by the State to manage this contract. The contractor shall provide the State of Alaska with an electronic usage report (Excel) which will list the following information at the minimum: purchasing entity, description of items purchased, date of purchase, contract price, retail price, and the extended price for each transaction. These reports are due 30 days after the end of the quarter.

July 1 through September 30

Second Quarter:

October 1 through December 31

Third Quarter:

January 1 through March 31

Fourth Quarter:

April 1 through June 30

All orders issued by purchasing entities within the state must include the Participating State contract number: 2016LAB0003 as well as the Lead State Master Agreement No. MA16000234-1.

## 6. Administrative Fee:

Contractor agrees to provide an Administrative Fee to the State of Alaska.

- a) Contractor shall submit a check, payable to the State of Alaska, remitted to the Department of Administration, Division of General Services for the calculated amount equal to 1.5% of the net sales for the quarterly period.
- Contractor must include the PA Number on the check. Those checks submitted to the State without the PA Number will be returned to Contractor for additional identifying information.
